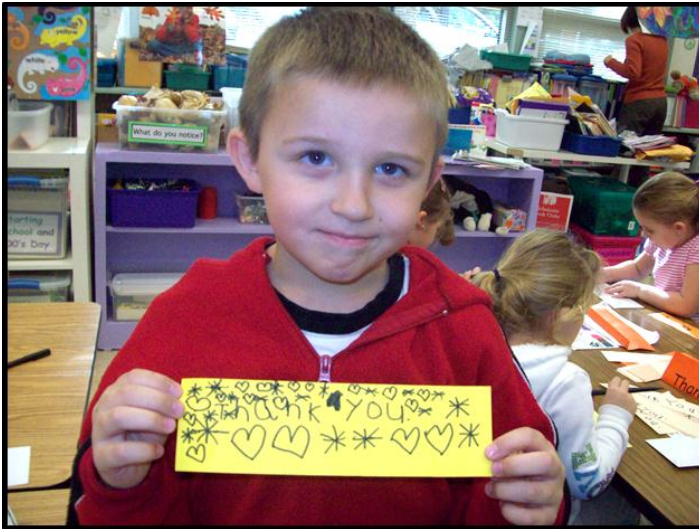
Children prepare secret messages to take home



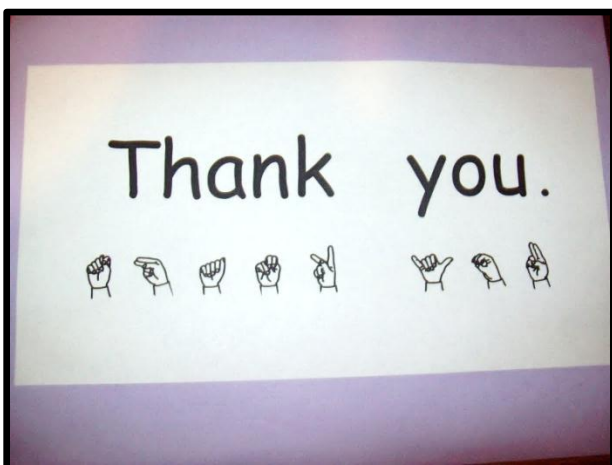
Do your best printing. (Children had practiced handwriting the word "you" earlier.)
