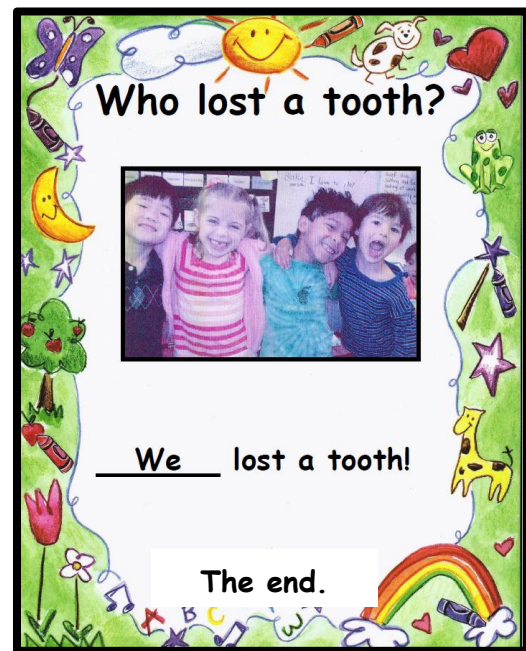
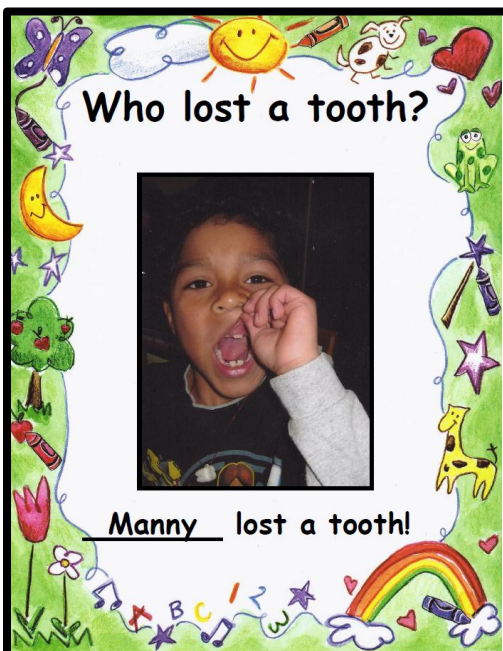
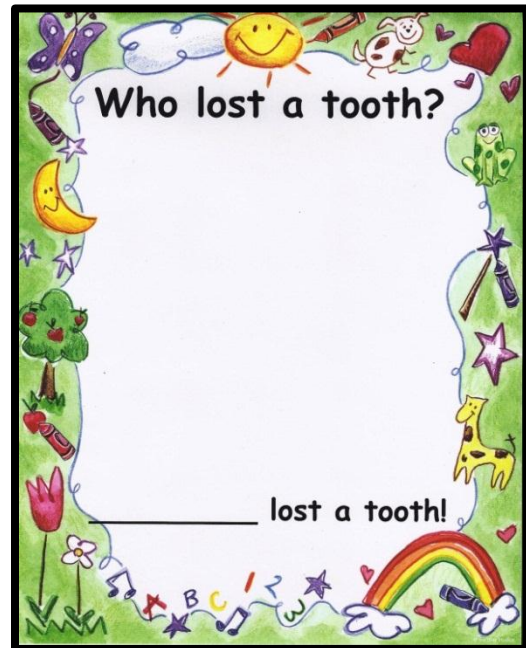
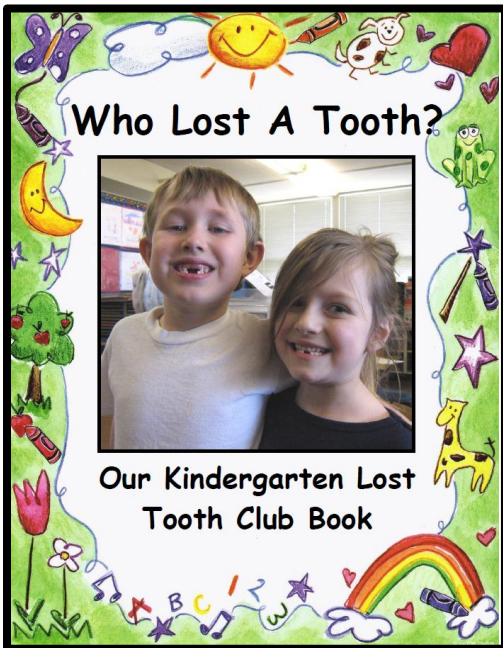


We Sing Songs and Create Class Books about the Lives of Our Kindergarten Children: Who Lost a Tooth?

When we create simple, meaningful class books, the children pour over the pictures and read the pages all year long.

Because time is so limited, we like to prepare a frame for this entire book using the same patterned writing on decorative pages (just waiting for a child's picture and name to be added!). Slip the title page into the front of a three-ring binder with a clear view cover. Individual pages of lost tooth photos are put into clear plastic sleeves. This is one of the ways we build community, celebrate the lives of our children, and give them opportunities to read meaningful text.
