Tips for Making Class Books and Gift for You!

- Start with one class-made book idea that will engage your students. When
 you are comfortable with the process, consider a second one. Use different
 colors of 1-inch 3-ring binders with clear sleeves to make it easier for
 students and the teacher find the books quickly.
- Arrange the book format to be vertical rather than horizontal; this helps the pages stay in place and avoids ripping.
- Make print on $8\frac{1}{2} \times 11$ pages large enough to use for shared reading.



- Store pages in heavyweight sheet protectors to keep books usable all year long.
- Consider writing the "About Your Teacher" book in English and Spanish or whatever the predominant first and second languages are in your community.
- Take advantage of the QR code for *I Love the Earth* to learn the new melody. Share class book songs with families: Learn to make your own QR codes!

• **Include a parent comment page** with any book that goes home for family sharing.



- At the end of the year, take each child's pages and bind or staple them together in a memory book or add them to the back of each child's "I Can Read" (Poetry and Song) Notebook. This becomes an end-of-year gift to families and provides great summer reading for students!
- Laminate the cover of each class book before slipping it into the outer sleeve of the binder so you can use year after year.




- Include a table of contents for books that feature a page for each child: Students will use it and learn to read names; they'll also use the numbers to find their own page.
- Include direction for families that encourage rereading with comprehension, fluency, and joy! (Early in the year, show families how to use the Neurological Impress Method (NIM) of guided reading practice and share Phonemic Awareness and Phonics strategies.)

 Teach American Sign Language (ASL) with *I Pledge Allegiance* and *Twinkle*, *Twinkle Little Star* class books. Take advantage of the editable pages to feature photos of your students. Give families copies of the ASL guide.


- A dedication page may be appropriate for some class-authored books as a way to honor a principal, student-teacher, or volunteer. Students will learn to read "Dedicated to..."
- Finish the book with a "t-h-e e-n-d, the end" page that children can fancy up. Use the QR code to learn the rhythm for our spelling chant "the end."
